4. Brennan-Rogers Magnet School will provide families with a link to:

- b. All Title I eligible services

5. In addition to the Family Involvement Policy. Brennan-Rogers Magnet School will develop the Title I required school-family compact as one of its components.

6. Brennan-Rogers Magnet School will periodically review and update its Family Involvement Policy annually to meet the changing needs of families and the school through:

7. Brennan-Rogers Magnet School will convene an Annual Meeting by October 31 of each year to disseminated required information.

This policy was adopted by Brennan-Rogers Magnet School on October 31, 2023 and will be in effect for the period of one year. The school will distribute this policy to all families of participating Title I, Part A children on or before January 31, 2024.
